**Subject: List of Perishables Goods/ Commodities**

The goods specified in the table below are notified to be perishable goods for the purpose of relevant articles of the Customs Code. The perishable goods have a limited shelf life and get deteriorated with undue delay. With a view to facilitate the trade, it is hereby ordered that in future all the consignments of perishable goods under Customs control shall be handled with care and processed and **cleared on priority** in accordance with the provisions of law. Before release of perishable goods, the owner or his broker shall pay the due duty/ taxes and the Customs shall properly observe the legal provisions, if any, prescribed in this regard.
